

It's also a short distance north to the Delville Wood military cemetery where some of Percy's comrades are buried, including some killed the same day.

Following further north to Courcelette then west to Thiepval and Beaumont Hamel



We visit several battlegrounds and memorials, including: Essex Farm (Advanced Dressing Station and John McCrae's poem "In Flanders Fields"), Pilckem Ridge (Gas Attack 1915), Langemarck German Cemetery, Vancouver Corner The Brooding Soldier Memorial, New Zealand War Memorial Gravenstafel, Tyne Cot Cemetery (The Third Battle of Ypres aka Passchendaele) and final stop on the tour Hill 62 (Sanctuary Wood) Museum with trenches, returning back to leper via Hellfire Corner.
